#### **GRACE-FULL**

I want to challenge you, as part of the Grace Family, about the consistency of your giving. I looked at the

figures for contributions from month to month over the past several months. Quite often the difference from one month to the next is at least \$800.00 and often well over \$1,000. How does that occur? Please note I'm not talking about the amount of the giving, I'm talking about the stability of what the church receives each month.

As I pondered why this would be, I recognized sometimes one's income varies, but a great many of our people either have fixed incomes from pensions and Social Security or they work at jobs that usually pay about the same amount from month to month. This is where the challenge part comes in. As I reflected on it, it occurred to me that giving may vary despite income if we don't set aside the "first fruits" for God each month from what we get. I challenge each person in this body of believers to



prayerfully consider what God expects you to do in giving as a part of this body—with your money and your loving action.


