### **Pastor Randy's Notes**

Last week I attended a seminar, along with Paul Young and Barbra Furman, the title and content of which I would have never imagined in my wildest dreams- "Active Shooter Seminar Amidst Violent Extremism at/on Faith Communities". Twenty years ago who would have ever thought faith leaders in America would be gathering to hear about what to do if an active shooter appeared at their house of worship? Not me, but there I sat!

Those in attendance were asked by the presenter to, "Raise your hand if you feel less safe now than when you were a kid." From what I could see about 90% of the 400-500 people in attendance raised their hands.

Following the show of hands, the presenter told us something very interesting. He said statistics say we are more safe today than we were 40-50 years ago. Murders are down, violent crime is down, as well as many other categories of crime.

So why the unsafe feeling? Back 40-50 years ago if something "bad" happened you might read about it in a short article in the newspaper, or hear a short report about it on the evening news. However, today, with almost instant access to information around the globe, every single story is "in your face". Some violent events have even been captured in real time!

Even though violent crime is down, what still exists is plastered all over everywhere for us to see and hear. And what happens? Our minds dwell on it. Thus we have the feeling more bad is happening today than in years past. As a result we feel less secure.

This reminds me of what Paul wrote in Philippians 4:8, "Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things."

We need not let our minds dwell on the negative things the world has to offer. We can always shut off the news, shut down our computer, or change the radio station.

We can look for the good in this world, and let our minds dwell on that. If you have a difficult time seeing the good, ask God, through the Holy Spirit, to open your spiritual eyes to allow you to see all the amazing things God is doing in this world.

Yes, we live in a sometimes violent world, but we do not need to live in fear. (By the way, you have a greater chance of being hit by an asteroid than being a victim of an active shooter.) We can, and should, let our minds dwell on the more noble things of God which bring hope and peace.

I can think of no better way to end this article than with the words of Paul out of Romans 15:13:

May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.
